

May I share with you five reasons why I am voting to re-elect Brock Belnap as County Attorney on June 24th.

1. Brock has eleven years of service as the County Attorney. His record is nearly impeccable, which is a remarkable feat when you consider his office handles approximately three thousand cases a year.
