As many of you are aware nearly two years ago in an effort to address some significant concerns and challenges affecting the Iron County Ambulance the department was merged with the Sheriff's department and became a division, where thanks to each of you many necessary improvements have occurred. However, after several years of operations running significant deficits the Board of Commissioners is evaluating options to assure the viability of an Ambulance service in Iron County. With several options available, and none being decided at this time, we are communicating directly with each of you to keep you informed as we formalize steps to look at available options. Among the options, privatization of the Ambulance service is being considered. The county is opening requests for proposal for the acquisition of the assets of the ambulance department to be used within the county. After proposals are received the county will determine which, if any, of the proposals will be acceptable to the county. We want you to know that during this process we will communicate with you directly. Whatever process we go through will largely be administrative.

The outstanding service of each of you to our community is greatly appreciated. We will keep you apprised during the process. Once again, we appreciate the service you provide in our wonderful community and understanding as we work through this process.
