Education Programs: Abstinence Education and Personal Responsibility Education	\$56,355	\$115,704	Under this contract, the grantee provides abstinence only education and a comprehensive sex education curriculum in schools. Planned Parenthood is one of many organizations (such as Local Health Departments) that receive grant funding to provide this education. The comprehensive sex education program cannot be taught during school hours and students require parental permission in order to enroll.	Health	Federal
