**Summit Academy** follows a curriculum to ensure a child learns required academic, behavioral, and social skills. Data is collected in each of these target areas. A child learns the following skills in developmental order.

**Attending:** Teach to focus on a task

**Imitation Skills:** Imitate simple objects

**Receptive & Expressive Language:**

Comprehend what is being read or said

Express wants and needs

**Cognitive(Pre-academic) Skills:** Sorting,

Sequencing, alphabet, numbers, etc

**Social Skills:** Child learns to interact and communicate with others

**Self-help Skills:** Eating, toileting, dressing, cleaning up and hygiene

**Behavior Management:** biting, hitting, spitting, screaming, tantrums, etc

**Following Directions:** Child learns to follow directions the first time

We serve clients of all ages to help them reach their highest attainable level.

### Ages 3-6

- *1:1 to 1:2 staff/client ratio*
- *15-30 hours services weekly*

### Ages 6-10

- *1:1 to 1:3 staff/client ratio*
- *15-20 hours services weekly*

### Ages 10-12

- *1:1 to 1:3 staff/client ratio*
- *15-20 hours services weekly*

### Ages 12-15

- *1:1 to 1:3 staff/client ratio*
- *10-20 hours services weekly*

### Ages 15-18

- *1:1 to 1:4 staff/client ratio*
- *10-20 hours of services weekly*

### Ages 18+

- *1:1 to 1:6 staff/client ratio*
- *10 hours of service weekly*
