

**WCRP RESOLUTION ON THE  
CORRUPTION IN 2012 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION PROCESS**

**WHEREAS** the declarative and governing documents of our party, state, and nation codify the nature of equality among the human race to mean that each individual is considered to be a single entity with equal protection under the law;

**WHEREAS** all voters deserve to have their participation in the political process represented fairly and proportionately;

**WHEREAS** the prominent and transparent evidence of voter fraud in the 2012 presidential election may have been material to the outcome:

To wit, but not inclusive of all reported examples:

-St. Lucie County, Florida, reported voter turnout as high as 166% in one precinct and no precinct lower than 113%.<sup>i</sup>

-Ohio reported 100 precincts with 99% voting for Obama, a statistical impossibility, and from a state that reflected very different results in pre-election polling.<sup>ii</sup>

-Some wards in PA, where Republican poll watchers were forcibly removed, showed 30% higher turnout than government numbers predicted and returned over 99% votes for Obama.<sup>iii</sup>

**WHEREAS** the integrity and virtue of the voting process is one of the necessary conditions that must exist for our elected officials to obtain the consent of those they represent;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Washington County Republican Party:

Expresses outrage over the clear fraud perpetrated in the recent 2012 Presidential Election, and great concern over the apathy in party and public leadership on all levels who have taken little or no action to investigate and reveal the depth and breadth of the corruption.

Enjoins the Utah State Republican Party to exert whatever influence possible, legal, political, or otherwise, to bear upon the Republican National Committee and public officials who have jurisdiction over the sanctity of the election process, to take an immediate and decisive role in uncovering, investigating and determining the source of the fraud, and to further rectify the damage, prosecute the perpetrators, and assure that our election process is protected from the abuse of power that threatens the veracity of our Constitutional Republic.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the Washington County Republican Party:

Instructs the Washington County Republican Party Chair to, within 10 days, deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Utah State Republican Party Chair, and asks that the State Party Chair deliver printed copies to Governor Gary Herbert, the Utah State Attorney General, all Utah state and federal legislators, and the Republican National Committee Chair to achieve the objectives stated herein.
