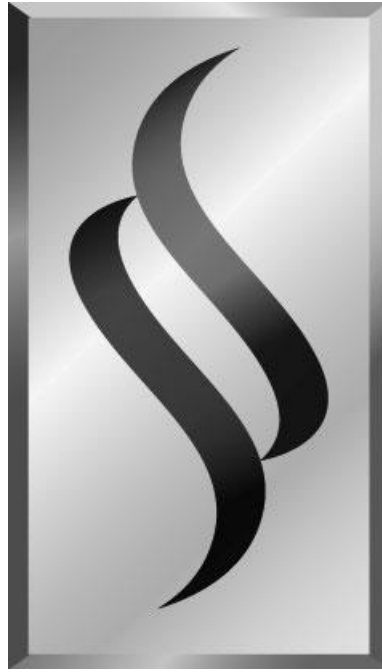
- \$200 cash award to each 2013-2014 Sterling Scholar Winner from Washington County School District.
