Thank you completing an excellent draft RMP and for requesting public comment. I strongly support Alternative C. It best reflects the level of protection and the types of use that defines a National Conservation Area.

The people of Southwest Utah voiced their opinion clearly when they reacted against the early 2006 Lands Bill, supported Vision Dixie in 2007 and its demand for the conservation of sensitive and scenic public lands, and supported the final 2009 Lands Bill which afforded these lands the intended protections by designating the Red Cliffs and Beaver Dam Wash National Conservation Areas. I strongly support implementing the intent of the Lands Bill and believe Alternative C reflects them. It affords the protection defined by the NCA designation in order to conserve and protect the scenic landscape and the fragile ecosystem while allowing light recreation such as hiking, biking, camping, horseback riding, fishing, stewardship of trails and heritage/archeological sites, etc. It disallows destructive uses or development such as the Northern Corridor highway and additional utility easements that are extremely stressful to the ecosystem. It focuses on protecting the environment and habitat to reduce further degradation and giving them a chance to survive.

Please continue to support the desire of the vast majority of regular citizens who want to conserve this land and its ecosystems for future generations.
