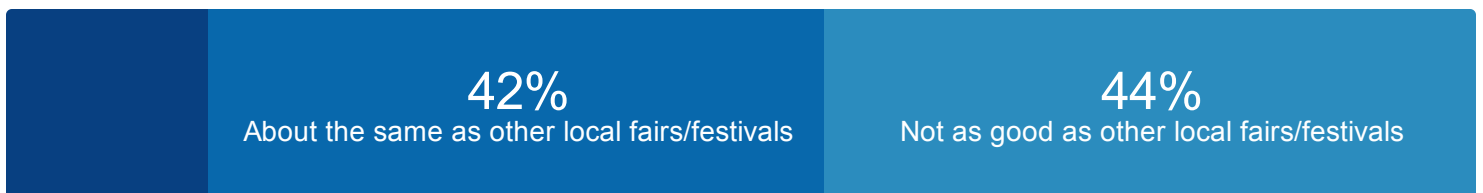
2. How would you rate your overall experience at the Washington County Fair?

■ Somewhat dissatisfied [26%, 409] ■ Very dissatisfied [12%, 189]



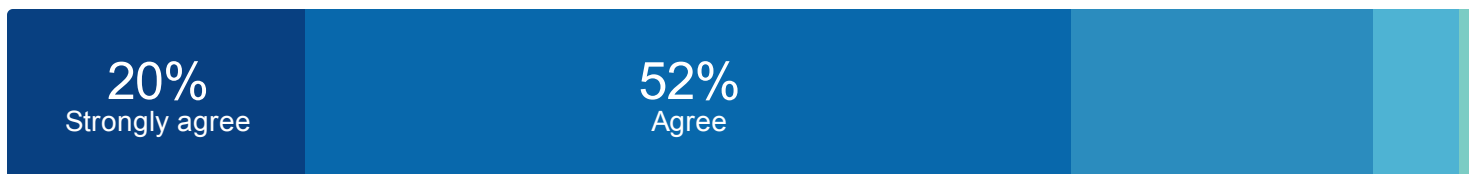

■ Not as good as other local fairs/festivals [44%, 684]



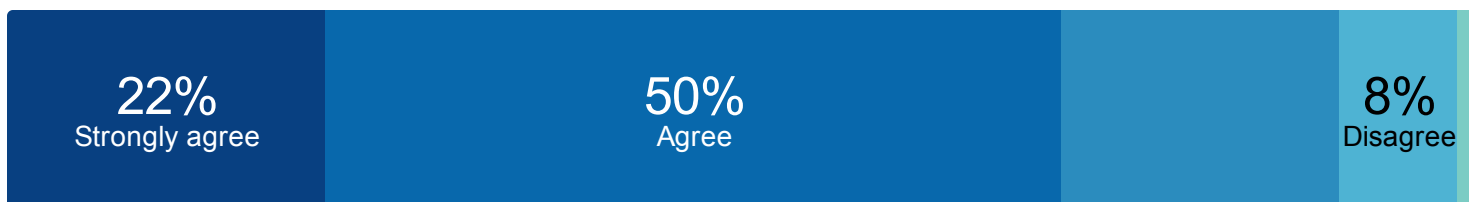
4. The Washington County Fair is a family friendly activity.

■ Strongly disagree [1%, 19]



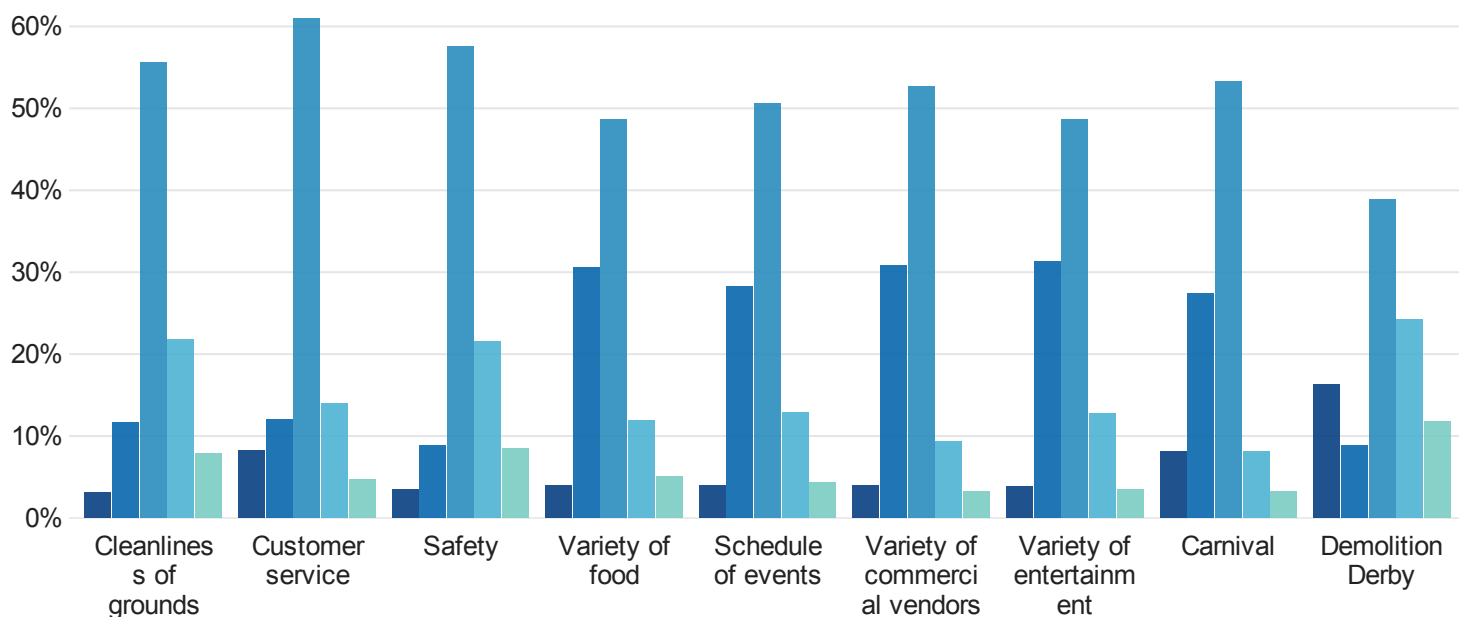
5. I feel safe taking my family to the Washington County Fair.

I'd like to see pig wrestling at the fair

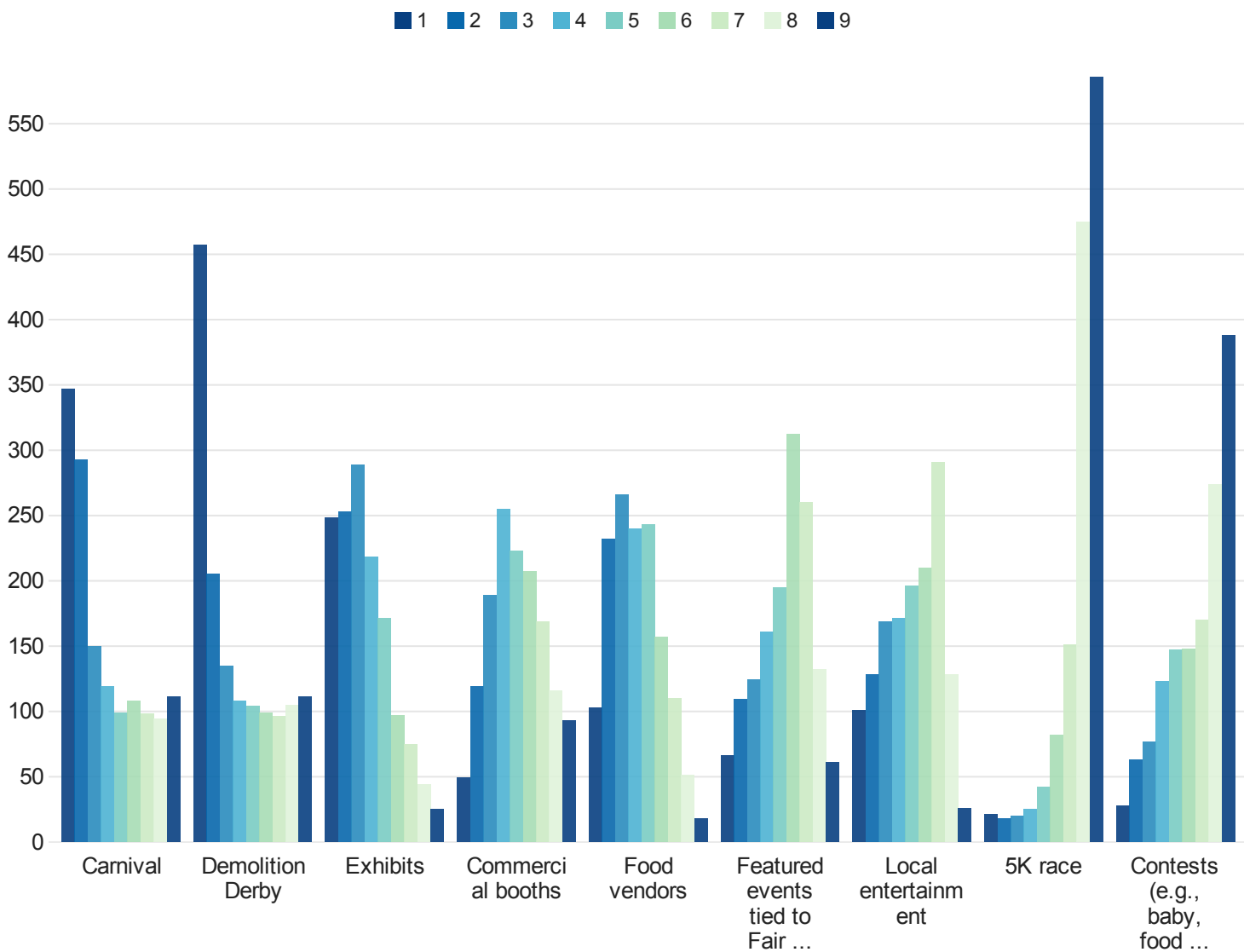
Bring back the boxing matches!

It's too hot to attend. Change the date

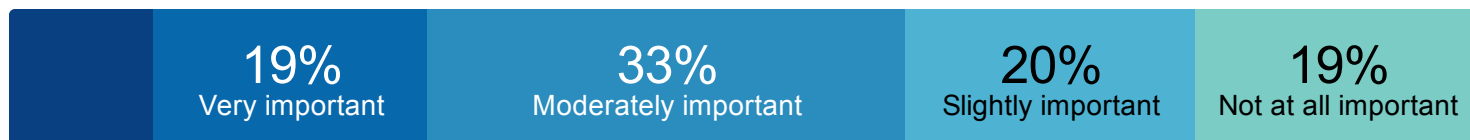

7. Please rank the following attractions at the Washington County Fair based on what you like most with 1 being your favorite (Drag and Drop):

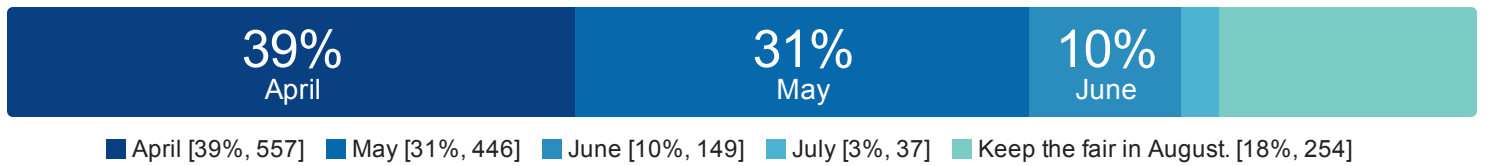


8. How important is the carnival to you?

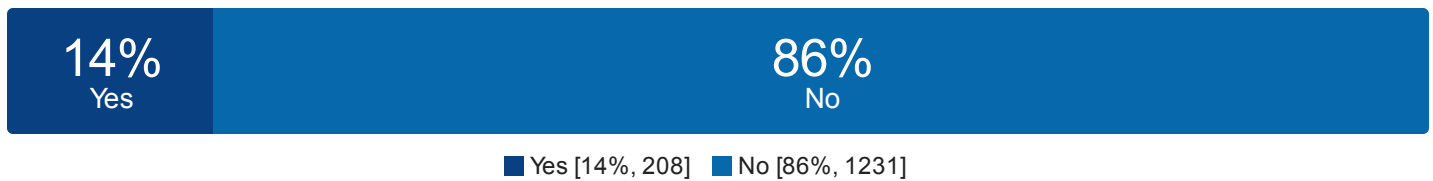

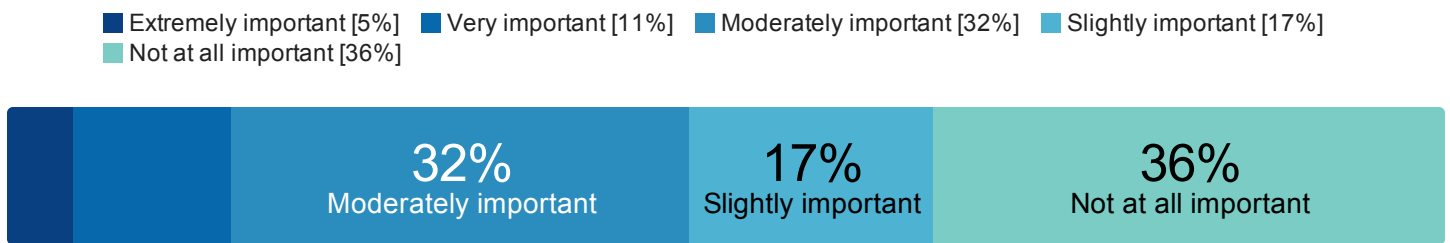
9. If the dates for the Washington County Fair were moved, which month would you prefer?

Prices are too high

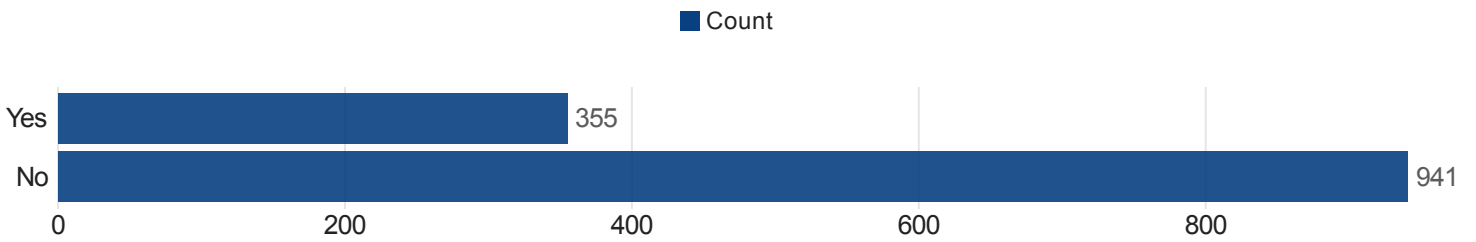
